Concept

Overwinter is a 20-30 page zine exploring the role of hibernation from creative productivity in my practice as an artist. In the modern world of the 24-hour news cycle and the even quicker lifespan of a photograph on social media, visual artists (myself included) often feel pressured to produce massive quantities of work to stay relevant for even one moment.

However, periods of rest and stillness accompanied by quiet introspection are crucial to me in evolving as a photographer: time spent absorbing life and growing beneath the blanket of ice and snow covering my world for the season. Until, eventually, the ground thaws and an artist emerges anew.
